HOTELS IN ROME

Hitherto dominated by stuffy baroque palaces, heavy with gilt, brocade and chandeliers, places to stay in Rome have improved dramatically of late, in both range and quality. A new breed of hotels is emerging, run by younger, well-travelled hoteliers and catering to a fashionable clientele rather than the Grand Tour stalwarts lost in some 19th-century fantasy of chintz and high tea.

Its tranquil and romantic position on the leafy Aventine hill makes the Hotel Sant'Anselmo one of the perfect hotels in Rome for a mellow refuge rather than a place for a high-octane party weekend. Rooms are ostentatiously styled with dramatic four-poster beds and decadent touches such as free-standing baths in some, although at times the décor feels a little naïve. A recent refurbishment has seen the addition of a huge column of Swarovski crystals in the stairwell, casting fragments of rainbows onto the chintzy sofas. In summer the relaxing terrace, with its idyllic views of the 5th-century churches Sant'Anselmo and Santa Sabina next door, is a pleasant spot.
